Additional Materials:

- Canson Mi-Teintes Paper, Pastelmat or similar
- Paper Towel (kitchen) - for cleaning Sofft Tools between colors
- Eraser - Les prefers to use a hard vinyl eraser. (If not available - any eraser will work.)
- Alcohol Based Markers (e.g. ProMarker, Copic, Touch etc)

- For "wet" techniques Les uses Pencil Blend (UK). If this is not available locally try the following solution:

50% rubbing alcohol + 50% water.

IMPORTANT Don't apply wet tools, fluids or mediums directly to the pan's surface. Liquids should be applied to the working surface (e.g. paper). So, apply the PanPastel Color first to the surface, and then apply the liquid wash with a sponge or brush to create the desired effect.
